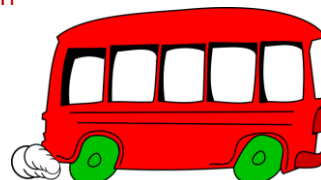

HEADLICE

Head lice are one visitor that we don't want within the school! Unfortunately, there are, as in any other place where there are groups of children, occasionally incidents of head lice in school. Fortunately, they can be kept at bay if we all take action as soon as we notice them. Please could all parents regularly check your child's hair thoroughly? The eggs in particular can be small and easy to miss. Please check, even if you don't think they have them.

If you see evidence of head lice, please treat your child's hair using a recommended method. You can find advice on the NHS website <http://www.nhs.uk/conditions/head-lice>, which outlines the best way to use either the wet combing method or 'over the counter' products. Continue treatment until the lice have gone, and check all members of the family.

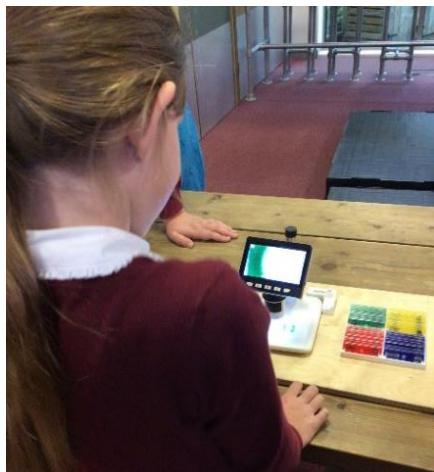
